P.T.A. may be deemed to be over on the first of 3 consecutive days of a recall of 12 When a patient scores 12/12, the picture cards must be changed and the date of change noted.
P.T.A. may be deemed to be over on first day of a recall of 12 for those who have been in PTA for > 4weeks (Tate, R.L. et al. 2006)
